Wasco Energy's Pipe Coating Division has been awarded a US\$ 162.9 million line pipe coating contract for the Chevron Gorgon Upstream Project.

The contract involves the coating of approximately 850km of line pipe. Work will be at Wasco's coating plant in Kuantan, Malaysia, and is expected to commence in the second quarter of 2010, with a completion target of 2012.

Sacrificial aluminium anodes associated with this project will be supplied by Wasco Energy subsidiary, Material Performance Engineering Sdn Bhd.

The Gorgon Upstream Project is a joint venture between the Australian subsidiaries of Chevron (Operator), ExxonMobil and Shell, to develop the Greater Gorgon gas fields, located between 130km and 200km off the Northwest coast of Western Australia. The Greater Gorgon gas fields contain resources of about 40 trillion cubic feet of gas; Australia's largest known gas resource.
